

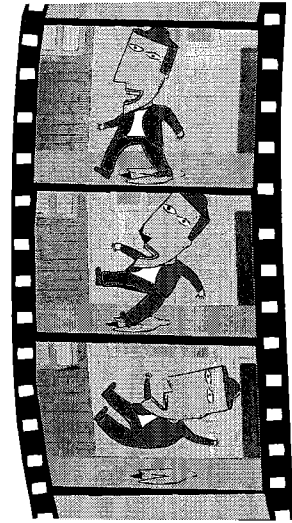
Book Club Novel - Storyboard

Your Objective for This Assignment:

Create a visual summary of the main ideas and significant details for your assigned book and present to the class.

Preparation:

- Carefully review your book.
- As a group, decide what the main idea(s) of the novel are and what significant details help to illustrate the main idea(s).
- Each group member should contribute an equal amount of work in creating the storyboard project. It is important for each person to stay actively engaged and contributing to the group at all times. Use the class time wisely!
- Complete the group role/planning sheet before beginning the storyboard and submit for approval.



How to Create the Storyboard

- Illustrate the chapters in a series of pictures that demonstrate the main ideas and significant details. (Make them large enough that they can be seen from student seats when put up on the blackboard.)
- Accompany each illustration with a caption explaining the illustrations.
- Find one quote that connects to each illustration and copy it by the drawing.
- You should provide at least 8 events (minimum) in the order they occur in your novel (sequencing).
- Write the names of all group members on the back of the storyboard.

You Will Be Graded On:

- your participation during the creation of the storyboard
- your role in the presentation of the storyboard
- the thoroughness of the storyboard and the information provided for your novel
- the score card completed by your group members on your participation.

Each group member must participate (equally) in the presentation of the storyboard. This means that all members must talk and explain a portion of the storyboard equal to that of the other group members.
